Successful applicants will be dedicated to the development of Additive Manufacturing / 3D Printing as part of an effort to create digital manufacturing platforms through the following;

- Act as principal investigator or co-investigator on research projects.
- Develop research objectives, projects and proposals.
- Conduct individual or collaborative research projects.
- Make presentations at conferences or exhibit work at other appropriate events.
- Assess, interpret and evaluate outcomes of research.

- Develop ideas for generating income, promoting research area and influencing leading edge practice.
- Act as research team leader.
- Mentor, coach and support colleagues with less experience and advise on professional development.
- Supervise the work of others, for example in research teams or projects
- Managing the use of research resources and ensuring effective use is made of them.
